

Kenosha County Genealogy Society
General Meeting Minutes
June 10, 2019

The meeting was called to order by President, Kathy Nuernberg at 6:30 PM in Room I - 131 conference room at Gateway's Inspire Center building. About 24 members attended and 8 visitors were welcomed.

Kathy requested to please turn off, or down any cell phones so no interruptions.

Oren Simpson was ill, so Kathy Nuernberg gave the treasurers report. Beginning balance of \$2,934.36 with expenses of \$80 for P.O. Box; \$180 for Insurance; and \$32.40 for Copy Center. Ending balance of \$2,460.24. Internal audit was done by Frank Klein and all was found to be in order. The educational fund bucket was passed around.

June election for Vice-President and Treasurer was conducted by nominating committee person Charlie Hermann. No opposing nominees came forward. Dawn Best and Oren Simpson both were not in attendance but agreed to serve another term. It was a unanimous vote to re-elect both people. The motion to accept was made by Brenda Lambert-Miller and seconded by Lorna Waldron.

Judy Uelmen, in charge of the Tombstone project spoke about starting this season at the cemeteries this Friday June 14th at St. Casimir cemetery. She explained how it's done and to have a camera and empty SD card, good to have a partner that cleans the stones, while the other takes the picture. The hours are from 9 AM – to 11 AM or later. A sign-up sheet was passed around. Kathy said if you go it's best to have a partner. St. George cemetery old section is every other Friday.

Kathy asked if anyone has checked out the new website? Two people raised their hands. In honor of the new website, we have pens available for a purchase price of \$3 each at the registration desk, we sold 5 tonight.

Saturday June 8th was our first Kenosha Harbor Market. We can go there once a month without being charged. We sold six folded books and some coasters for a total of \$192.00. In the back of the room we have folded books available good for Father's Day and Graduations for \$25.

The meeting concluded at 6:44 PM. It was accepted by Kathy Nuernberg and seconded by Charlie Hermann.
